GROWING GREEN: TREE CANOPY IMPROVEMENT STRATEGY 2021-2045


Our City is GROWING GREEN

Help us make our City greener, cooler, healthier and an even better place to live.

Our City is getting hotter from the impacts of climate change and the urban heat island effect. Trees provide cooling benefits, support our health, create a sense of place and produce important habitat. Planting trees is an investment in the future of our City. The mature trees we enjoy today were planted by those generations before us.

The Tree Canopy is Currently in Decline

We need a Tree Canopy Improvement Strategy to provide a planned approach to arrest the decline we are seeing in our tree canopy cover, primarily due to the loss of trees on private property from infill development.

Our target is to reach a tree canopy cover of 25% by 2045

GROWING GREEN Vision

The City of Charles Sturt has an extensive, healthy, diverse and sustainable urban forest which grows to reach a City-wide canopy cover target of 25% by 2045.

GROWING GREEN Commitment

We will achieve this vision by increasing resources with a dedicated focus on planting more trees, whilst maintaining, protecting and retaining our existing trees, and engaging our community to enable action to protect and retain trees in both the public and private realm.

GROWING GREEN Guiding Principles

1. Plant more trees.
2. Have a plan and set a target.
3. Protect more trees.
4. More tree maintenance and management.
5. Appreciate trees more.
6. Monitor and evaluate our progress (and change course if we need to).

There are 41 actions in the strategy that align to the 6 principles.
