Groundwater

Stormwater / Borewater

We could develop an understanding of what the implications to the community are regarding groundwater contamination and on what living in a proscribed area means.

Contaminated groundwater - EPA and how they can communicate effectively with the public

Investigate wetland or other water quality improvement opportunities along River Torrens from Tapley's Hill Rd to the beach

Water quality - issues with pollution plumes from Torrens outlet heading north. Council should work on improving water quality with other councils and within new developments

Potential for Council involvement in Blue Groper project on Gulf St Vincent water quality currently occurring via Onkaparinga

Potential partnerships with universities / SARDI / CSIRO regarding contaminated soils and groundwater - whether alternative remediation methods can be suitable and how; appropriate communication on groundwater; understanding implications ie on health and property values etc

Look at options to divert stormwater to trees especially along main roads

Stop use of borewater among residents!

CCS could look at membership of Blue Flag or similar water quality indicator group - allowing use of an existing framework

Need to undertake communication and research relating to contaminated sites and groundwater - what can be done? What remediation is possible? Suitable communication on issues?

For public space: Remediation of contaminated land where possible. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar 12]
