BUS/TRAIN TRAM AWARENESS

Park and Ride - rather than use the car

Free park n ride at West Lakes shopping centre to encourage use of public transport

Development of transport interchanges / hubs. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

To improve connectivity between transports: Investigate to improve compatibility - improved physical connections. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Better signage to improve connectivity between transport types [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Awareness of community bus services / times / frequency. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Identify destinations / facilities at the end of the journey. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Lobby Government / providers to coordinate times / frequency of service / improved parking (e.g. Kilkenny station) to improve public transport use [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Transport- Council needs to look at its own fleet

Make a slip lane on Port Rd for "drop-offs / pick-ups" at the tram stop at Entertainment Centre. Increase safety, increase usage.

Advocacy for high quality and good quantity of public transport services;

More staff to use train (TOD!) rather than take up so many carparks

HERE!

Get rid of bus lane on West Lakes Blvd and substitute with train/tram

Clean up Albert Park rail station - make it more appealing and it will be used

Rather than using cars to go to school, people should use a bike, scooter or walk on foot
Promote and implement car swap / car-sharing such as Go Get program in more locations around Council in addition to the one starting at Bowden

Promoting our fantastic cycling networks – coast park, linear park, wayfinding signage along local bicycle networks, how to better promote and further improve on this (e.g. the walking/cycling strategy Council is currently developing, events e.g. in conjunction with the VeloCity conference next year)

Policies and infrastructure to make cycling safe and enjoyable for both commuter and recreational cyclists

There should be more bike lanes on main roads

Bicycle access to West Lakes ie bike lanes

Better streetlighting and footpaths to encourage walking and cycling (ie for school children)

Safer roadways for community cyclists

Develop and implement bike use courses such as Smart Movers to make cycling

Could look at car pool options for staff as many live within the area

PLAN

BIKES Truck and line

Develop plan and implement infrastructure to make cycling and walking more pleasant ie. Directional signage, bubblers, bike lockers / racks

- Coordinated. Develop local City plan or paths, lanes on roads etc. [Dev't Plan w/shop Mar12]

Encourage bicycle and pedestrian movements through infrastructure provision and changing traffic flows (ie one-way streets for cars which allow two-way flow for bikes)

Dedicated bike paths off road

Bike riding - need to focus both as a mode of transport and for recreational short distances

Council could continue Bring & Fix workshops where experts teach people to look after their bikes; and/or foster an Adelaide Bike Kitchen or similar (one located at Bowden) to help people become more comfortable riding bikes

Initiate car-free days; provide better pedestrian and cyclist signage
