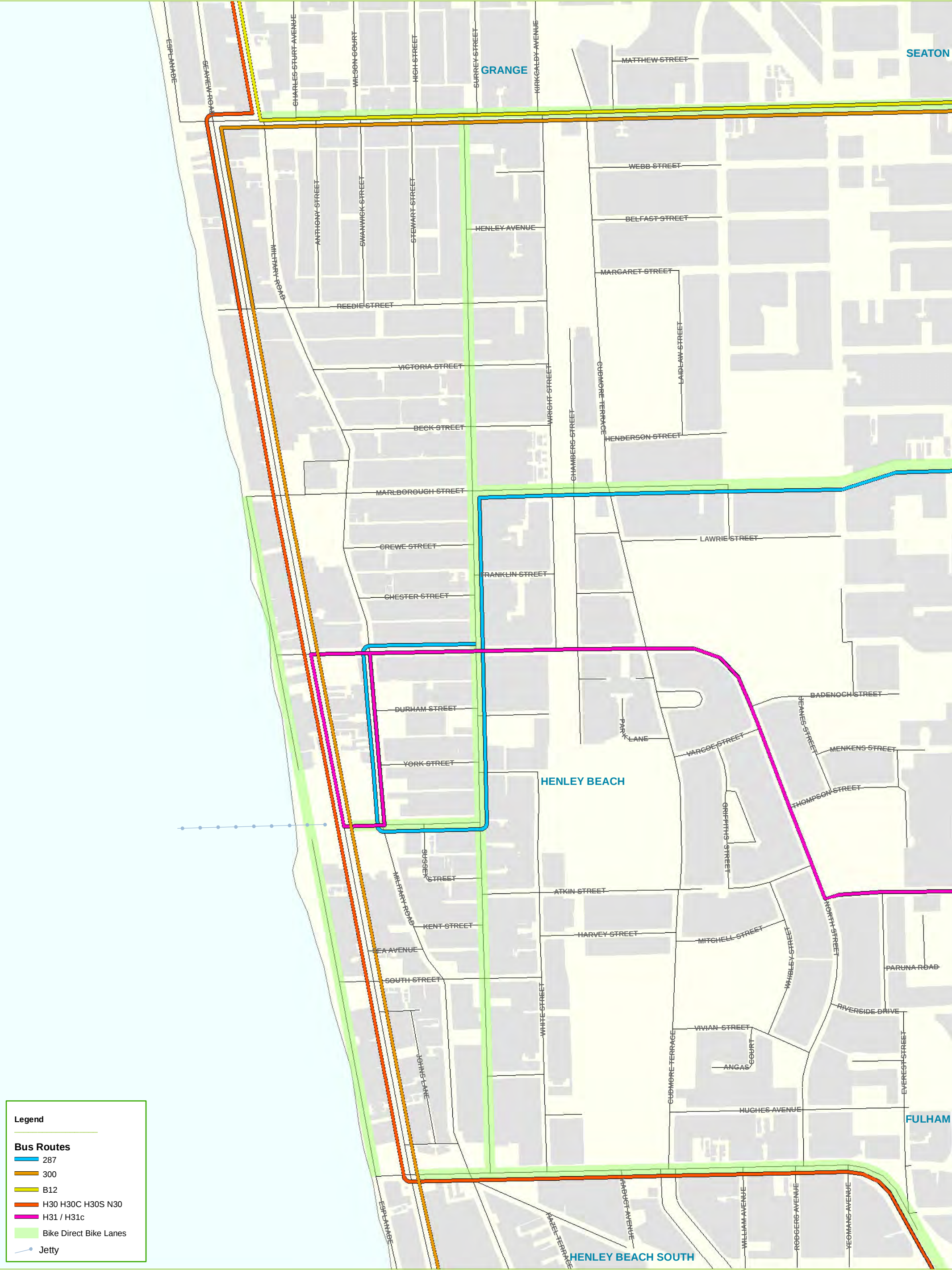


Existing Transport Network and Survey Mapping

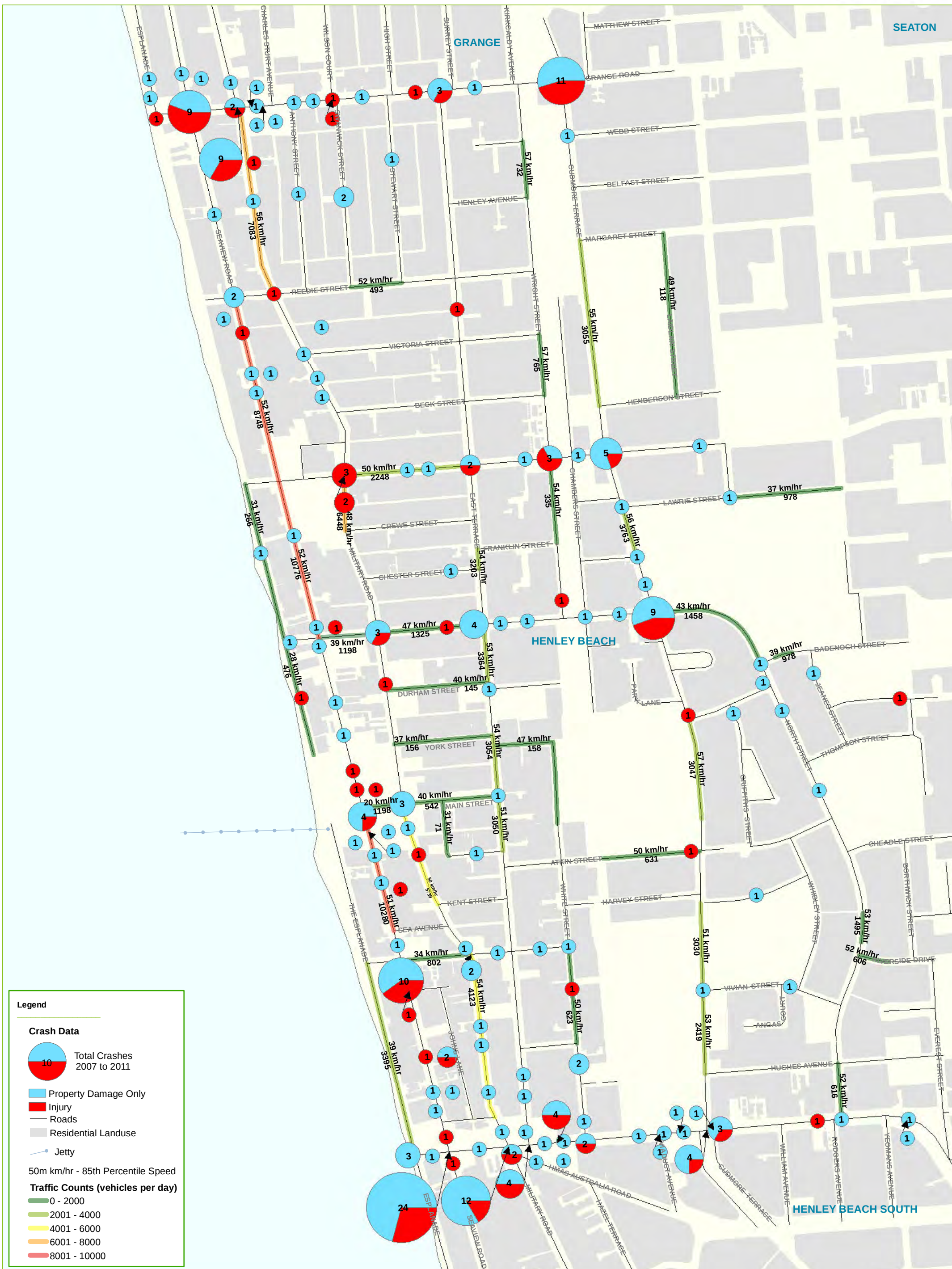
