### INTRODUCTION /

The Trail Collective (TTC) have been engaged by the City of Charles Sturt to deliver design and construction for Bower Road Bike Park, located on the corner of Old Port Road and Bower Road in West Lakes / Queenstown, South Australia.

This document outlines preliminary design concept plans to identify considerations, opportunities and possibilities for an improved Advanced section and areas in need of repair. Ultimately providing the City of Charles Sturt community with an improved bike park, that is fit for purpose and enjoyable for its users.


#### **BASELINE INFORMATION**

An initial audit inspection of the site was provided to the City of Charles Sturt in 2017. The audit inspection report identified the need for several improvements to the site to reduce safety concerns and improve the user experience; with a priority focus on the drainage issues and Intermediate and Advanced Sections. The City of Charles Sturt have since acted on this report and requested fees from specialist contractors though the formal procurement process.


#### CONSULTATION AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT


