Council has received a request from Glen Duncan to display his artwork "Dream" within the City of Charles Sturt for a period of 12 months.

About the sculpture

The sculpture consists of a seat and a wave structure. The artwork is 2.4m wide x 3m long and 2.2m high. It is made of stainless-steel recycled wine transfer piping, recycled timber, acrylic and solar lighting. It was recently on display at the Brighton Jetty Classic Sculpture event.
